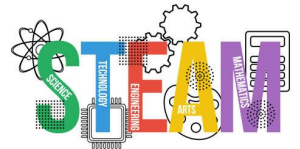
I am putting out another call for parent volunteers for our Life Skills program. Our goal is to have at least one parent volunteer for each class and we are far short of that goal.
